*Attending volleyball camp is not mandatory.

*LHS will continue with 4 teams: Varsity, Junior Varsity (2) and Freshman.

Coach Sandoval discussed that LHS has a new athletic director, Todd Howey. He is in the process of making some changes that may affect the booster club and the players. However, the changes will benefit the program and instill pride in the club. One of the changes is our volleyball uniforms can no longer be black. Our school colors are not black and uniforms should represent the school colors. Any other changes that impact the club will be shared as they arise.

Mary Howard asked the booster club if they were interested in participating in a fundraiser for the booster club. This would be a 6 week fundraiser at the T-ball concession stand and would require 3-4 people, 4 nights a week. All proceeds would go to the club. After much discussion, the booster club is not interested at this time due to the amount of money we have in reserves as well as the commitment involved. Many of the players and parents are currently in club ball and unable to commit.
